Why this seminar?

Although BPS has improved the capacity of enumeration and tabulation for various statistical surveys as well as for censuses by own efforts, Indonesia has not yet possessed enough knowledge and techniques to construct an information system of small-area statistics and to prepare statistical data derived from the system. This Seminar introduces wide range of the users the usefulness of those small area statistics which will be prepared and provided during the period from August 2006 to July 2008 by the Project for Developing the Information System of Small Area Statistics.

Small Area Statistics

"Small area" in the Project refers to the areas including "Grid Squares" and "Census Blocks" developed for statistical purposes as well as administrative areas such as Kabupaten/Kota (regency/municipality), Kecamatan (district), and Desa (village) under a Propinsi (province). The Small Area Statistics refer to the statistics compiled or prepared on the basis of those small areas described above.
